Florida Private School Scholarships

Applications are available for children to attend an eligible private school that best fits their learning needs.



If a child is in a school that is not meeting his/her needs, we may have the help they need.

A child may qualify for a scholarship to private school if:

He/She is a child in foster care is defined by the following:

"Foster care" means care provided a child in a foster family or boarding home, group home, agency boarding home, child care institution, or any combination thereof, as defined by s. 39.01(29).

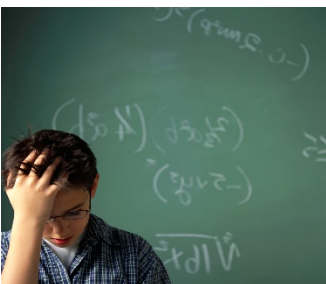
OR

He/She is a child in out-of-home care placement is defined by the following:

Out-of-home" means a placement outside of the home of the parents or a parent, as defined by s. 39.01(48) which is further defined as the placement of a child in licensed and non-licensed settings, arranged and supervised by the department or contracted service provider, outside of the home of the parent, as defined by DCF Rule: 65C-30.001 Definitions. (91).

Your child must be accepted by an eligible private school under their normal admissions policy. Students must follow all academic and discipline policies of the individual school.

Schools are free to dismiss students who do not comply.
