Human Trafficking Awareness Month

January is Human Trafficking Awareness Month and across the nation, law enforcement and other organizations are working to eliminate it. Human Trafficking involves the use of force, fraud, or coercion to obtain some type of labor or commercial sex act. Traffickers exploit the vulnerabilities of others (like poverty, trauma, abuse, or homelessness) for financial profit. Children in foster care are disproportionately victimized by human trafficking. It is estimated that 60% of child sex trafficking victims have a history in the child welfare system.
